



Re: FIS racing in Finland during C-19 pandemic

Ski Sport Finland as the governing body for alpine skiing in Finland is notifying all teams that due to current epidemiological situation travel restrictions set by the Finnish government on September 11th, remain in force. Accordingly, only essential travel to / from Finland is recommended. Sport related travelling and entry to Finland is subject to special permit granted by the Ministry of Sports, Finnish institute for health and welfare and The Finnish Border Guard to a race organizer. Furthermore, these institutions and local health authorities have stated that permits will be granted only to the World Cup and Continental Cup events.

In the current situation we ask the Teams not to enter Finland nor to contact border officials directly on travel related matters. The Finnish Government is working on a new entry model based on testing. This model originally slated for Nov 23rd has been delayed until December 13th. We hope the decision, when taken, will allow international races to take place in due course.
